There is a cafe/ bar meeting place at Warehouse 6 throughout the hot weekend. Most events are free but some are limited audience or ticketed. (Tickets available from HTBA or the Information Centre ticket office, Victoria Square.) Please make sure you collect your artist's pass and vouchers from the HTBA office.

The **ROOT '95** civic launch is at the Ferens Art Gallery, 6pm, Friday 13th October, coinciding with performance work by Anne Seagrave, and Jordan MacKenzie at the Ferens, and Seiji Shimoda at Warehouse 6. Works by Stephen Hurrell and Keith Stutter will also be shown at the Ferens, and Thomas Sterna at the Eich Gallery. (See catalogue for details).

The **Forum Civil Liberties and Civic Pride** takes place at Warehouse 6 at 2pm, Saturday 14th October. The discussion will be chaired by Dennis Fyle of the Hull Afro Caribbean Society, attended by Humphrey Forrest of The Law Society, and representatives of the Freedom Movement. The **ROOT '95** artists will also be there. All are welcome. Admission free.

Hull Screen are hosting a media programme on the 12th, 13th and 14th October including screenings of new international film and debate of issues of *civil liberties* in particular in relation to new technologies. (See catalogue or Hull Screen for details).

Warehouse 6 is the location of an Internet link with **Real Liberties**, an interactive, proactive information site by Ann Whitehurst. Log on and contribute. A new work by Heath Bunting is also to be found on the Net and throughout the city.

Axiom -p(art)y - takes place at Warehouse 6, Saturday 14th October, 9pm - late. It is a ticketed event so please book early.

On Sunday 14th October **The Trialists** takes place at Ennerdale Leisure Centre. Virgil Tracy will be inviting football fans and non football fans alike to try out for a virtual football team. The selected Hull team will consist of candidates with vision and flair rather than technical competence. Everyone is welcome and entry is free.
